**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 7 FOR THE PURPOSES OF
PROVIDING NECESSARY UPDATES AND FOR CLARIFYING CERTAIN
PROVISIONS**

The City Council of the City of Alexandria does hereby ORDAIN:

SECTION I. That Section 7.07 of the Alexandria City Code is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following:

“Recreational Vehicle Parking and Trailer Parking. It is unlawful for any person to leave or park any recreational vehicle, as defined herein, on or within the limits of any street or right of way, except where signs are erected designating the place as a campsite, for more than twenty-four (24) hours. It is unlawful for any person to leave or park any trailer, detached from its towing vehicle, on or within the limits of any street or right of way or within any municipal parking lot or ramp.”

SECTION II. That Section 7.15 of the Alexandria City Code is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following:

“Parking Restrictions in Municipal Parking Lots and Ramps. In municipally owned parking lots and ramps, the Council may limit the sizes and types of motor vehicles, recreational vehicles, and trailers to be parked thereon, hours of parking, and prescribed method of parking, provided that such limitations and restrictions are sign-posted or meter-posted thereon. It is unlawful to park any vehicle or trailer in any municipally owned parking lots and ramps contrary to the restrictions or limitations so sign-posted or meter-posted.”

SECTION III: That Section 7.19 of the Alexandria City Code is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following:

“Reserved Parking - Off Street Parking Lots. Subd. 1. On city-owned off street parking lots, the City of Alexandria may issue reserved parking permits for individual parking spaces on an annual basis. The issuance of permits and identification of reserved parking spaces shall be determined by the City Administrator. Reserved spaces shall be used only in conformance with the provisions of Sections 7.07 and 7.15 herein , marked by appropriate signs, and the application for such a parking space shall identify by vehicle the designated occupant of the reserved parking space.”


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.


